



**CODE OF GOOD PRACTICE
OF THE INTERNATIONAL PhD SCHOOL AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALMERIA**

Approved by the Standing Committee of the International PhD School's Board of Directors at the University of Almería on January 19th, 2017.

Royal Decree 99/2011, of January 28th 2011, which regulates official PhD teaching, states that PhD schools need to have a Code of Good Practice. Given that the University of Almería approved a Code of Good Research Practice in 2011, it is agreed that the Code of Ethics that all members of the International PhD School at the University of Almería (EIDUAL) have to sign is indeed the cited Code of Good Research Practice - this considers said school competent to recognise the conflicts and allegations that their members might bring up, without prejudicing the competencies of the responsible Vice-Rectorate of Research at the University of Almería.
