



REGULATION REGARDING A SECOND AND THIRD THESIS DIRECTORS

Article 18 of the Official Doctoral Studies Regulations of the University of Almería indicates in point 2: - 2. The doctoral student may have one or two co-directors, with prior authorization from the Academic Committee, provided there are reasons of a research nature that justify it.

In order to regulate the **inclusion of a second or third director**, the EIDUAL Steering Committee in session on 07/22/2020 agrees the following:

- 1) The inclusion of a second or third director must be requested **by the doctoral student** to the International PhD School through the CAU ticket system of the University of Almería, **within the first two academic courses of student enrolment**.
- 2) Assigning a second director:
 - a. An explanatory statement giving the academic reasons advising the incorporation or modification of a second director must be submitted to the program's Academic Committee for assessment.
 - b. The assignment of a second director is undertaken by the Academic Committee of the student's doctoral program.
 - c. The doctoral program coordinator must inform EIDUAL of the assignments for their administrative processing.
- 3) Assigning a third director:
 - a. An explanatory statement giving the academic reasons for advising the incorporation of a third director must be submitted to the program's Academic Committee for assessment.
 - b. A third director may be requested in the case of an international co-supervised thesis and the foreign university's thesis supervisor may act as such.
 - b. The assignment of a third director is undertaken by the Academic Committee of the student's doctoral program.
 - c. The doctoral program coordinator must inform EIDUAL of the assignments or modifications for their administrative processing.
