Blended intensive programmes (BIPs) are short, intensive programmes that **use innovative ways of learning, for students combining virtual components with short-term physical mobility** and providing an opportunity to reach out to new groups of students. Blended Intensive Programmes is a new format of Erasmus+ mobility and support an important enlargement and flexibility of Erasmus mobility. **Each participant should get from their sending institution mobility grant.**

Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences, Babeş-Bolyai University in Cluj-Napoca, will organize between **15 – 19 of May 2022, the Blended Intensive Programme Evidence-based practices in educational sciences and psychology.**

E*vidence-based practices* is the approach that the practices should be based on the best available scientific evidence, rather than tradition, personal judgment, or other influences. So, the evidence-based practices in education and psychology are based on actual scientific evidence resulting from studies or the collection of a lot of data from many different sources. Therefore, this Blended Intensive Program is focused on several lectures and workshops aimed to develop to the students' knowledge, skills, and attitudes regarding the relevance of the evidence-based practices and to highlight how they could use them in different educational and psychological contexts with a high success rate.

Preliminary programme. Topics in focus

On-line part

The students will be involved in a mandatory on-line course about the relevance and the importance of the evidence-based practices in educational sciences and psychology. This part will take place a week before the on-site part, for 2 hours.

On-site part

During the Blended Intensive Programme in Cluj-Napoca, the students will benefit from a keynote lecture and several workshops focusses on subjects as:

- ✓ *The unexpected ways your brain learn.*
- ✓ *Evidence-based practices for critical thinking development.*
- ✓ *Evidence-based approaches to wellbeing and mental health.*
- ✓ *How to provide meaningful feedback.*
- ✓ *Learning How to Learn: Evidence-based learning strategies.*
- ✓ *Development of communication and social skills through theatre methods.*
- ✓ *Teaching and learning in 3D world. Immersive authentic teaching with metaverse.*
